

NC Family Policy Council

1. * I think the Marriage Amendment should define marriage as the union of one man and one woman at one time. It is important to add at one time to deal with cases of polygamy, polyandry, bigamy, and other types of arrangements people may wish to claim.
2. * Health benefits should go to those in a marriage or to any legally recognized children.
7. * It is important in any action which may infringe on the constitutional right to free speech that we are clear on our definition of indecent and obscene media content.
9. * If the Ten Commandments are allowed for public display will we also be required to recognize religious documents from other non-Christian or non-Jewish believers? If so, then people should be encouraged to believe and worship as they may but allow others the same right.
14. * Stem cell research is important to our understanding of human diseases, growth and development as well as potentialities. The ethical question isn't simply the destruction of a human embryo, but the ability of fertility research to allow one person an unfettered opportunity to produce dozens of human beings without checks or balances.
15. We are all guided in daily decisions by our personal belief systems. Does one group have the right to impose its belief system on others who may not hold those beliefs. Yes if it is a matter of upholding laws to maintain order and the social good. When the issues are those of moral judgement I am willing to let people be guided by their own belief system.
